

## **COVID-19 Fuel & Pumpout Procedures**

Fuel and Pumpout are by appointment only.

- » Please text (preferred) or call Jim Pickett at 203-215-6238 for an appointment.
- » We will do our best to accommodate our member's needs.
- » Fuel or pumpouts may not be available on days that boats are being hauled or launched.
- » Please abide by all physical distancing guidelines.
- » There will be no more than two boats allowed on the dock at any one time.
- » We will not be accepting any customers without an appointment at this time.
- » Any person who gets off their vessel must be wearing a face covering (mask, bandanna, etc.).
- » Please be patient with our Staff and follow their directions.

## **Fueling**

- » When approaching the dock, please provide your own lines and have them ready for the Dock Staff to assist you in mooring your vessel.
- » Members or visitors are required to fuel their own boats and wear a face covering and gloves when doing so.
- » Any crew that steps off the vessel must be wearing a face covering.
- » The Staff will bring the fuel hose to you and lay it on the deck.
- » When you are done fueling, please lay the hose on the deck.
- » All payments must be handled through the upriver (East Side) window of the Gas Shack.
- » PLEASE DO NOT ENTER THE GAS SHACK.
- » When vessel departs, our Staff will untie your lines and toss them into your boat.

## **Pumpout**

- » When approaching the dock, please provide your own lines.
- » Place your line on the boat hook that will be extended by the Staff.
- » Anyone that steps off the boat must be wearing a face covering.
- » Please moor your vessel on the side that your deck fitting is located. The Staff will not board your vessel under any circumstances.
- » Our Staff will perform the pumpout service.
- » When vessel departs, our Staff will untie your lines and toss them in your boat.
